

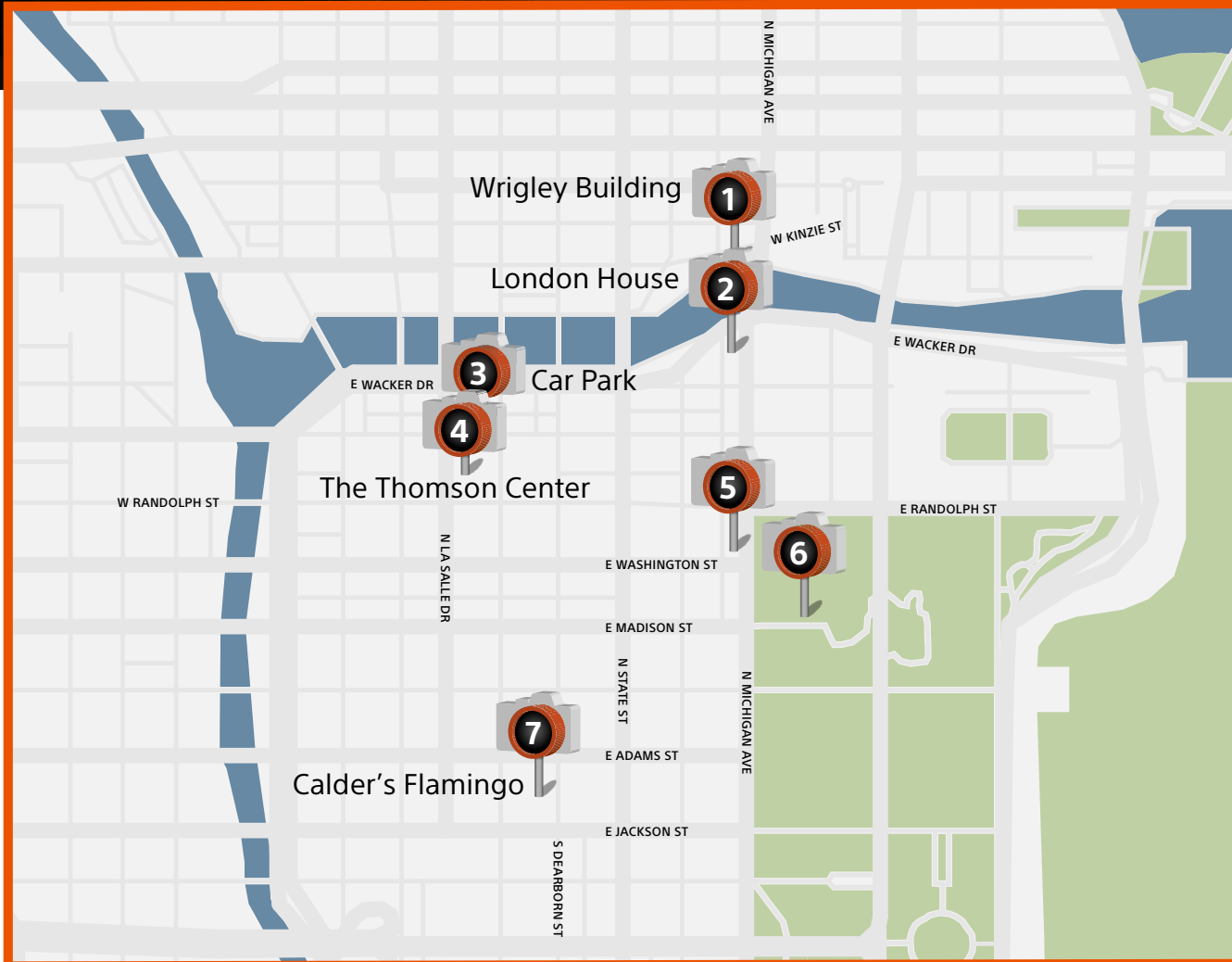

- 1 **Wrigley Building**
So many great angles to try here.
- 2 **London House**
Inside London House, if you head to the top floor you can get a classic view of the Chicago River.
- 3 **Car Park**
Head into the car park on Clark to around the 7th floor and use a 16-25mm GM for great shots!
- 4 **The Thomson Center**
Open on weekdays with fantastic shots throughout.
- 5 **Tiffany Dome**
Easy spot and a few different shots available.
- 6 **Cloud Gate**
You cannot walk Chicago and not go to Cloud Gate, more affectionately called "The Bean." Hard to get a bad shot.
- 7 **Calder's Flamingo**
There are many angles that you can shoot this from and wide angle lens is best.
